

Selby Winter League 2021 – 2022

Rules

1. There are 2 Leagues, divided into different bow disciplines.

Portsmouth: 5 Dozen arrows at 20 yards on a 60cm target face, metric scoring.

Frostbite: 3 Dozen arrows at 30 metres on a 80cm target face, metric scoring.

2. Teams throughout the Leagues will consist of the following number of archers:

Recurve – 3 archers

Compound, Barebow & Longbow – 2 archers

3. Threshold additions applied to every Division score are as follows:

Recurve – 100 points

Compound, Longbow & Barebow – 75 points

Any team score over the Division threshold will be subjected to an “adjusted” monthly score. For every point over the threshold score, 1 point is deducted off the threshold score.

For example

Division score 1500

Threshold addition 100

Division threshold 1600

If a team scores 1630 then they are over the Division threshold by 30 points so a deduction of 30 points is taken off the Division threshold giving an “adjusted” score of $1600 - 30 = 1570$

4. The scores submitted must be shot in the required month.

5. Each team shoots one match per month throughout the duration of the competition.

6. If a month's shoot cannot take place, the Competitions Officer will forward a nil result so a credit for a loss can be given.

7. If you are drawn against a “Bye” a score must be submitted for a win to be allocated.

8. Given the Covid-19 social distancing restrictions it is not necessary for archers to shoot at the same time, but it is encouraged for archers to nominate a date they will shoot their score.

9. At the end of the month the scores are taken from highest to lowest and placed in the “A” Team, then “B” Team and so on, if multiple teams are entered.

10. Points will be awarded as follows: WIN – 3 points, DRAW – 2 points, LOSS – 1 point

11. All matches are to be shot under Archery GB rules. Any ties on score will be determined in the following order. Score, Hits, Golds, 'X's.

12. Score sheets must show Hits, Score, X's & Golds and the date each archer shot their score.

13. The Organiser will send each club a copy of the up to date league positions following each month's submitted scores.

14. Badges will be awarded to the teams winning each division at the end of the competition. It cannot be guaranteed all team members will receive a badge.

15. The Organisers decision shall be final in all matters.
